




**Figure 2.** The share of world military expenditure of the 15 countries with the highest spending in 2022



#### **Logic of Security**

Logic of Peace

What is the problem? Threat, danger, insecurity

Actions aim to:

Avert danger and defend oneself

Who or what caused the problem?

How is

the problem

addressed?

The problem was caused by others / External factors

Actions are aimed at:

Blaming others while safeguarding and protecting one's own interests

By defending and protecting oneself

Actions taken:

Unilateral means, including escalatory ones expansion of the security apparatus, deterrence, threat or even use of direct force

How do actors justify their deeds?

By asserting that their own interests prevail

Courses of action:

Values and norms are re-defined, subjected and adapted to one's own interests

How do actors react to failure?

By affirming rather than reflecting critically on themselves

Approaches to action are directed at:

Intensifying the means used so far and, if necessary, withdrawing and ignoring the situation

Actions aim to:

Protect people from violence and distress - prevent, reduce and deal with the effects of violence

Any violence that is imminent, takes place, has taken place

The problem is a result of destructive conflict dynamics

Actions are aimed at:

Transformation on the basis of a comprehensive understanding of conflict, including own contribution to or role in the conflict

Through civil conflict transformation

Approaches taken:

De-escalating, dialogic, confidence-building, cooperative measures - excluding direct violence

By using the ethos of humanity - human rights and international law

Courses of action:

Implementing norms, modifying one's own interests, recognizing the legitimate interests of others

By reflecting oneself, learning experientially, willingness to recognize mistakes

Approaches to action are directed at:

Dealing constructively with mistakes, avoiding harm through impact assessment, closing perception gaps, implementing non-violent alternatives


#### Positive Examples: Civil Peace Service

# Mali und die Sahelzone: Fragen des Engagements

Die globale Studie "Wie Frieden gewonnen wird - von zivilem Widerstand zu dauerhafter Demokratie" weist zivilen Widerstand als Schlüsselfaktor bei 50 von 67 Transformationen autoritärer Staaten zwischen 1972 und 2005 nach.<sup>26</sup>

It is clear that in the short term, security in Europe must be organized, unlike Russia. In the long term, however, the European security architecture, while still requiring smart defense, needs to be rethought beyond traditional alliances and agendas to include Russia as a European state.

# Rethinking European Security

The 'Turning Point: Realising a Sustainable Security Architecture for Europe' project – referred to as 'Rethinking European Security' – is driven by the need to generate a sustainable security systems change in Europe and beyond.



# Rethinking European Security

Therefore, a new security architecture will include a trinity of traditional or hard, human and climate papers. These three aspects are interconnected and inseparable from a modern understanding of security. It is not enough for states to focus exclusively on traditional security without taking into account broader security aspects.

This project brings together representatives of the selected member states of the Organization for Security and Co-operation in Europe (OSCE). In 2024 and 2025, five regional workshops will take place across Europe, bringing together government representatives and experts from more than 30 European countries.

The conversations are driven by a research-based working paper produced by BASIC, which highlights the issues that need to be considered in order to develop a new security architecture.

# Rethinking European Security

Workshop participants will co-educate and explore opportunities for the development of a new security model in Europe that prioritises human security and environmental security alike with traditional security concepts.

After the completion of the recommendation model for security of participants in Europe, the report "A New Model for Security in Europe" will be launched at the final conference in Vienna in 2025 with the participation of Track 1 and Track 2 from all countries that have dealt with the project.

We will present our findings to international organisations, institutions and experts from the European community and turn the vision of a new model for security in Europe into reality.



# Rethinking European Security

On September 19, BASIC and Rethinking Security hosted a Track 1.5 workshop in Warsaw entitled "Designing a Sustainable Security Architecture for Europe" with participation from Central and Southern Europe, including Croatia, Czech Republic, France, Italy, Poland, Portugal and Spain.

The third of five workshops that the Risk Reduction Programme and Rethinking Security will host in 2024-2025 as part of our project "Turning Point: Realising Sustainable Architecture in Europe" aimed to develop a model for the future of European security architecture.
